Sukyo-ji Temple was founded as the family temple of the Yamana Family in the Muromachi Era. Then, Priest Takuan revived this temple at the beginning of the Edo Era (1616). Therefore this temple was called Takuan-dera and became popular.

Since its establishment, the temple building has endured severe natural wear, such as heavy rain and snow for over 400 years, and some parts of the building have been severely damaged.

Consequently we decided to reconstruct the temple.

This would be a good chance to use local wood in the Tajima region and hand down temple construction techniques to the next generation as well as preserve the forest.

We name this reconstruction "Takuan-dera Revival Project, Circle of Life", aiming to leave sustainable ideas for future generations.

All of us have a strong passion in our heart. We have to keep it and share with the people around us through our activities.
